As an adult playing member or volunteer at **Dundee Korfball Club**, you are expected to abide by the following code of practice:

- To act in the best interests of Korfball at all times, and not to act in any manner that is improper or brings the sport into disrepute.
- To play within the rules of the sport and to respect the officials and their decisions.
- To clear up their own litter, and that of any teammates who forget to do so, after all events.
- To respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- To abstain from using violent, threatening, abusive, indecent, or insulting words or behaviour.
- To keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- To wear suitable kit, including indoor trainers, for all training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- To pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- To pay any fines incurred under club or competition rules.
- To pay any charges incurred for breakages or damage to club equipment or property.
