There will be a marquee in front of the astroturf gate. Registration, the referees' meeting, the raffle and the presentations will take place there.

Venue: **Dawson Park, Arbroath Road, Dundee, DD5 1PJ.**

Limited parking is available at the car park on Dunottar Place. This can be accessed (from Dundee city centre or Kingsway/ring-road) by turning right off the A930 down Fairfield Road, turning left on Strathern Road, and taking the next left.

The astroturf at Dawson Park is marked on the appended map as the All Weather Pitch, beside the West Pavillion.

Surface: The tournament will be played on sand-based astroturf and care should be taken to avoid falls on the surface. Appropriate footwear should be worn; **studded boots are not permitted**, but normal trainers or **astroturf boots may be worn**.

Showers/Toilets: We will have access to separate male and female changing rooms throughout the day, but there is only one set of toilets and showers. Shower times will be rotated by gender in 15 minute blocks from 16:00.

Refreshments: Barbecued food, cakes, soft drinks and water will be available throughout the day in exchange for donations to cover costs.

Conduct: Please remember that we are not the only users of the park, and that Dundee Korfbal Club's reputation and relationship with the local authority could be harmed should there be any inappropriate conduct. In particular, please respect the park's no alcohol policy, and dispose of litter into the bins provided.

Format/Rules: This will be a traditional, outdoor, single-day event for teams of 8 players. Normal korfbal rules will apply, without shot-clocks, but with rolling substitutions. The scheduled start and end times for matches will be signalled by an air horn, however the referee's whistle will be the official start and end of each match. Teams and referees should be ready to set up divisions at least 2 minutes before the game's scheduled start time.

This year's format involves two round-robin groups (7-teams in each pool), followed by one-off 'final placing' matches (first vs. first, second vs. second, etc.). Pool matches will be 15 minutes long, with no half-time breaks. Two points will be awarded for a win, and one for a draw. Rankings will be settled on points, then by the head-to-head record of any tied teams, then by goal difference, and finally by goals scored. Should there still be a tie at this stage after all games have been played, a penalty shootout between the tied teams will be held (five penalties each, followed by sudden death where needed). Placing matches will be 25 minutes long, with no half-time breaks. Teams will be informed of the placing match draw during the afternoon (raffle-draw / photo-shoot) break.

Referees: Each team will be required to referee either 3 or 4 matches across the day, depending on results; we therefore suggest that teams have more than one individual willing to referee. Referees are attached to teams, not to clubs, and it is therefore acceptable for any individual to referee a match involving another team from his/her club. The format (with more than one ref per team) should prevent any individual going more than three games without a rest (two games as a player and one as a referee).

Should any of your referees wish to be supported by a more qualified referee, please contact us before the tournament, or as early as possible on the day, and we will attempt to arrange this.

All individuals expecting to referee should attend the referees' meeting at 10:20.

Discipline: Referees will be encouraged to use yellow and red cards, where appropriate, when faced with any form of misbehaviour, including disrespect and dissent (whether verbal or gestured). There will be no fines or reports for yellow cards, but red cards (including two yellow cards in one game) will be penalised by a ban for the rest of the day, and a conduct report to the Scottish Korfbal Association or such other National Governing Body as is appropriate.

Charity Fundraising: In support of DKC member Shaun Anderson we will be raising funds for two cancer-related charities, Macmillan and Orchid, at this year's tournament. Several local companies and individuals have generously donated over £300-worth of prizes for our raffle and lunchtime competitions, including vouchers, alcohol, confectionary and a shiny new korfball. We hope that you will help to make their donations worthwhile by buying tickets and joining in. The funds that we raise will be split 50:50 between the two charities.

Dawson Park

Dawson Park is the result of a bequest in 1940, by Mr William Dawson of Broughty Ferry "for the purpose of providing playing fields, sports grounds or other recreational facilities and the upkeep and maintenance thereof...for the citizens of Dundee, and particularly those of Broughty Ferry." The ground was purchased from the Douglas and Angus Estate in 1949, and the park was opened in the mid 1950's.

The park has feature plantings, a sunken garden, and a formal cherry avenue along the north axis, which is particularly stunning in spring.

Duntrune Demonstration Garden, which aims to provide information and ideas for small gardens, is also located within the heart of the park.

Park Guidelines

3. Alcohol is prohibited in all of Dundee's public spaces.
4. Cyclists: please act responsibly towards other park users.
5. Golf / golf practice is not permitted in Dawson Park.
6. Dogs must be under close control or on a short lead, at all times
7. Dog waste is a Health Hazard: **NOT** cleaning up your dog's mess can incur instant fines. (The Dog Fouling (Scotland) Act 2009)
8. Littering is punishable by instant fines.
